InfyTQ is a platform where students can register and get **Infosys Certified** which will help them to get a job as System Engineer or a Power Programmer. InfyTQ portal has many foundation courses in Programming, Database Management, and Behavioral Skills etc.

The webinar session speaker Ms. Kamaljeet Kaur who gave us overview of InfyTQ.

Then, **Ms. Shaan Vats** arrived for a face-to-face session. She is an HR head at Infosys who gave the students detailed information regarding InfyTQ and its benefits. She added that this exam is for all engineering branch students. This certification will help students to get an opportunity to work in Infosys as a System Engineer Specialist (5 LPA) & Power Programmer (8 LPA). These job roles are generally offered to Tier 1 and Tier 2 college students only. In addition to that, students with active backlogs also have a golden opportunity as there is no criteria for minimum CGPA or percentage when applying through InfyTQ.

Then she talked about **HackWithInfy** which is India-wide coding competition for final year engineering students. It provides students with the ideal starting point to explore their passion for programming, as well as the opportunity to compete and win the chance to work with Infosys. HackWithInfy includes three rounds with Round 1 and Round 2 as online tests which consists of 3 coding questions each and a grand finale with a 24-hour hackathon at Infosys Pune. The contest provides a platform to students to practice and enhance their programming skills.
