2. Procedure for Obtaining NBA Affiliation:

- Eligibility Criteria: Prof. Garg explained that institutions must meet certain criteria, including having a certain number of faculty members with relevant qualifications, well-defined program outcomes, and adequate infrastructure, to be eligible for NBA affiliation.
- o **Self-Assessment Report (SAR):** One of the key steps in the process is the preparation of a Self-Assessment Report. This document provides detailed information about the institution's programs, resources, teaching methods, and outcomes. The SAR serves as the basis for the accreditation review process.
- Online Submission and Fee Payment: Institutions are required to submit their SAR online along with the necessary fee. The submission includes evidence supporting their claims and data related to the quality of their programs.
- Peer Review Visit: After the SAR submission, a team of experts (peer review committee) from NBA visits the institution for a thorough evaluation. This team assesses the institution's adherence to the standards set by NBA. They review infrastructure, faculty qualifications, curriculum design, student support, and research initiatives.
- Outcome and Accreditation Status: Based on the findings from the peer review visit, NBA grants accreditation status. This can range from a few years to a longer period, depending on the institution's performance. Institutions are required to submit regular progress reports to maintain their accreditation status.
- Post-Accreditation Follow-up: Prof. Garg also highlighted the importance of post-accreditation actions. Institutions must continually improve and adhere to the NBA guidelines to retain their accreditation. This includes periodic reviews and updates to the academic programs and teaching methodologies.

3. Challenges Faced During the Accreditation Process:

- One of the main challenges identified by Prof. Garg is the complexity of the documentation required during the accreditation process. Institutions often struggle with organizing and providing sufficient evidence for all the requirements.
- Continuous Improvement Requirement: Accreditation is not a one-time process.
 Institutions must continuously improve their programs and processes to maintain NBA accreditation. This involves monitoring and adapting to changing academic standards and industry needs.
- Cost and Resources: The accreditation process can be resource-intensive, requiring significant financial investment, administrative effort, and time. Smaller institutions may face challenges in meeting the required standards or in providing the necessary resources.

Conclusion



- Ensure that all stakeholders in the institution understand the NBA process and collaborate towards achieving the accreditation goals.


