Test Structure

The mock test was divided into three distinct sections designed to evaluate multiple competencies of the students:

3. **Cognitive Section:** 45 Questions – 45 Minutes | This section assessed logical reasoning, quantitative aptitude, and verbal ability.
4. **Coding Section:** 2 Questions – 30 Minutes | This section evaluated programming skills and problem-solving abilities through practical coding challenges.
5. **Core Domain Section:** 30 Questions – 30 Minutes | This section tested domain-specific technical knowledge relevant to the students' area of study.

Test Process & Proctoring Guidelines

The mock test was conducted under strict AI-proctoring guidelines to ensure the integrity of the assessment and to simulate real-world examination conditions. Students were required to comply with the following mandatory requirements:

- Allow Camera and Microphone access before starting the test.
- Click and verify a photograph at the beginning of the session for identity confirmation.
- The camera must remain ON at all times during the entire duration of the test.
- Any form of malpractice, suspicious behavior, or violation of proctoring norms was to result in the immediate termination of the test.

The mock test session served as a valuable preparatory exercise for students, offering them a realistic experience of placement-style assessments. It helped students identify their readiness levels across cognitive, technical, and programming domains. The use of AI-proctoring further familiarized students with modern examination environments, which are increasingly being adopted by leading recruiters.
