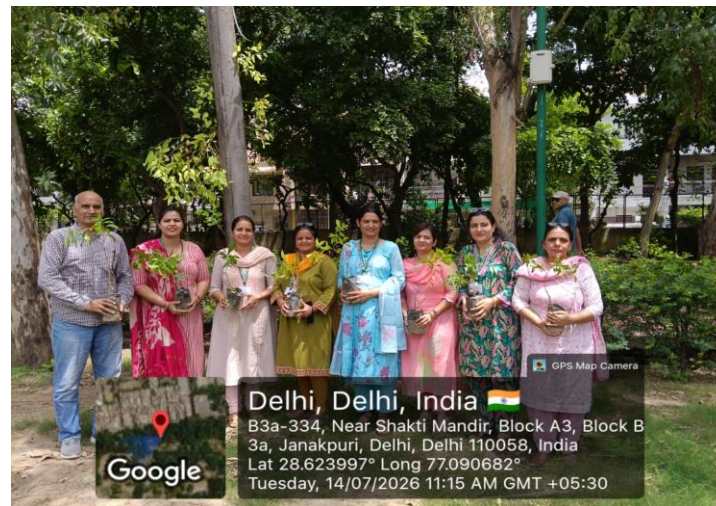
Objective:
